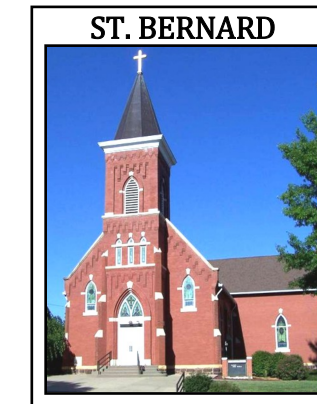

St. Isidore the Farmer (c. 1070-1130)

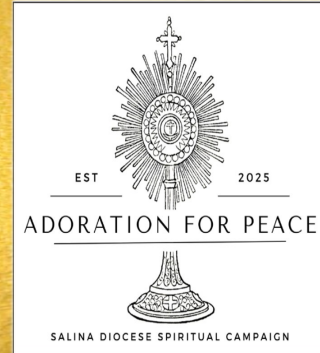
