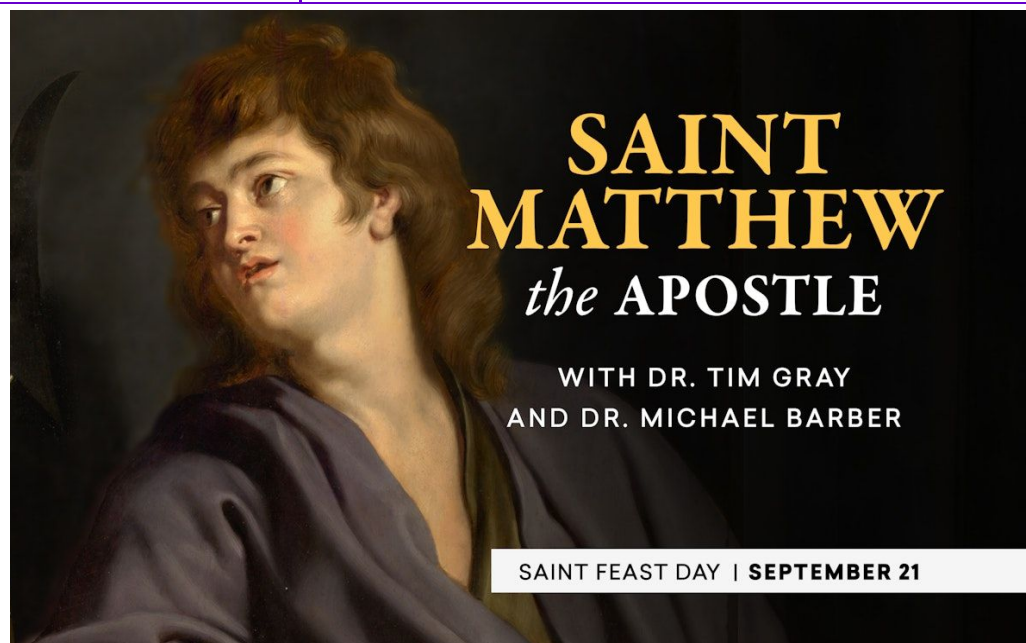

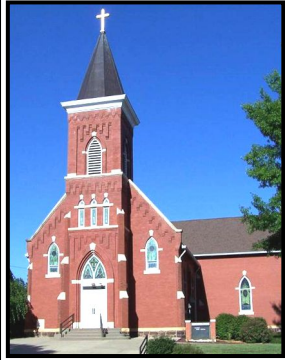
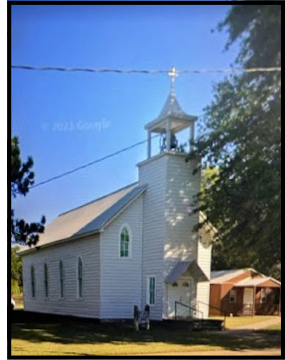

They met with Tim Linenburger of Painting & Decoration, Inc. who specializes in church repairs. Tim gave us a bid of \$99,000 to repair and paint the ceiling, paint the walls and stencil. The council voted to approve it. While our church does have the funds in savings to cover this project, we would like to start fundraising to help offset the cost.
