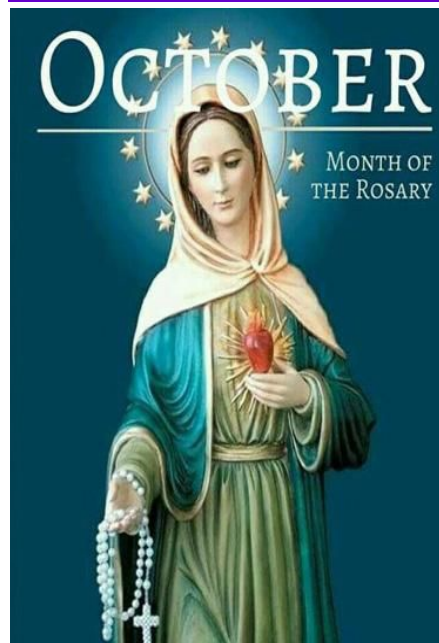

"In all of God's creation we see such splendor, beauty, mystery, and wonder. Within this creation there are beings with intellect and free will: humans and angels.

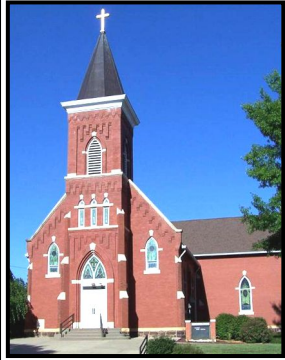
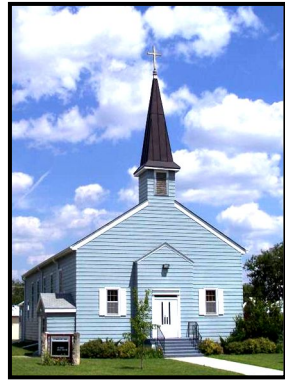
From the creation of the world, the realm of the angels and the world of men have interacted. This interaction is not always a positive one.

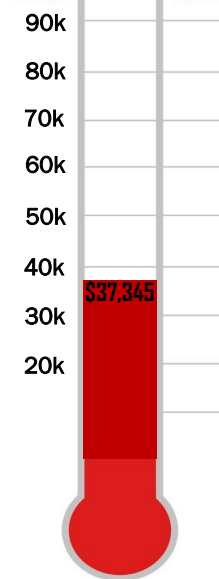

Church Restoration Project

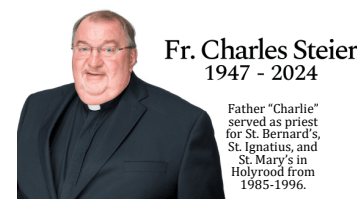
\$99,000



Over time the ceiling in St. Bernard's church has began to crack and discolor. The parish council recently voted to get the ball rolling on this project, and have the sanctuary restored. They met with Tim Linenburger of Painting & Decoration, Inc. who specializes in church repairs. Tim gave us a bid of \$99,000 to repair and paint the ceiling, paint the walls and stencil. The council voted to approve it. While our church does have the funds in savings to cover this project, we would like to start fundraising to help offset the cost. Fr. Charles Steier
1947 - 2024

Father "Charlie" served as priest for St. Bernard's, St. Ignatius, and St. Mary's in Holyrood from 1985-1996.

Fr. Charles Lee Steier, beloved priest and dedicated servant of the Diocese of Salina, passed away on September 22, 2024 Hays, Kansas. He was born 1947, in Belleville and Mildred (Kaliyoda) S and grew near Haddam, Kansas. He was the oldest child with five brothers and two sisters.

Fr. Steier pursued his calling with deep commitment, studying at St. Mary College in St. Mary, Kentucky, Immaculate Conception Seminary in Conception, Missouri, and Kenrick Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri. He was ordained on June 8, 1973, by Bishop Cyril Vogel at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Concordia, Kansas.

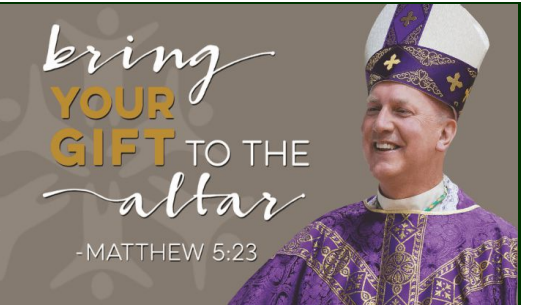
Beginning with his first assignment in 1973 to the conclusion of his most recent in 2024, Fr. Steier served in various parishes. He began his priestly ministry serving as parochial vicar from 1973 to 1977, first at St. John the Baptist in Beloit and later at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Hays. Beginning in 1977, he went on to lead numerous parishes as a Pastor, including: St. Joseph in St. Joseph, St. Isidore in Cuba, Saints Philip and James in Phillipsburg, St. Mary in Smith Center, St. Francis in Claudell, St. Bernard in Ellsworth, St. Ignatius in Kanopolis, St. Mary in Holyrood, St. Mary Queen of Angels in Russell, and St. Mary Help of Christians in Gorham. His service as a Pastor concluded in 2024 at Christ the King Parish in WaKeeney and St. Michael Parish in Collyer.

Fr. Steier's unwavering faith and pastoral care touched countless lives over his 50 years of ministry. He was granted full retirement in 2024, leaving behind a legacy of love, compassion, and dedication to his community. He is survived by his family, friends, and the many parishioners who cherished his guidance and leadership. Fr. Charles Steier will be deeply missed and fondly remembered.

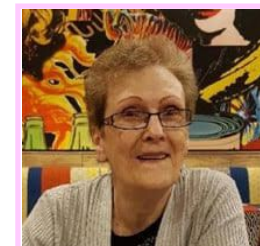
