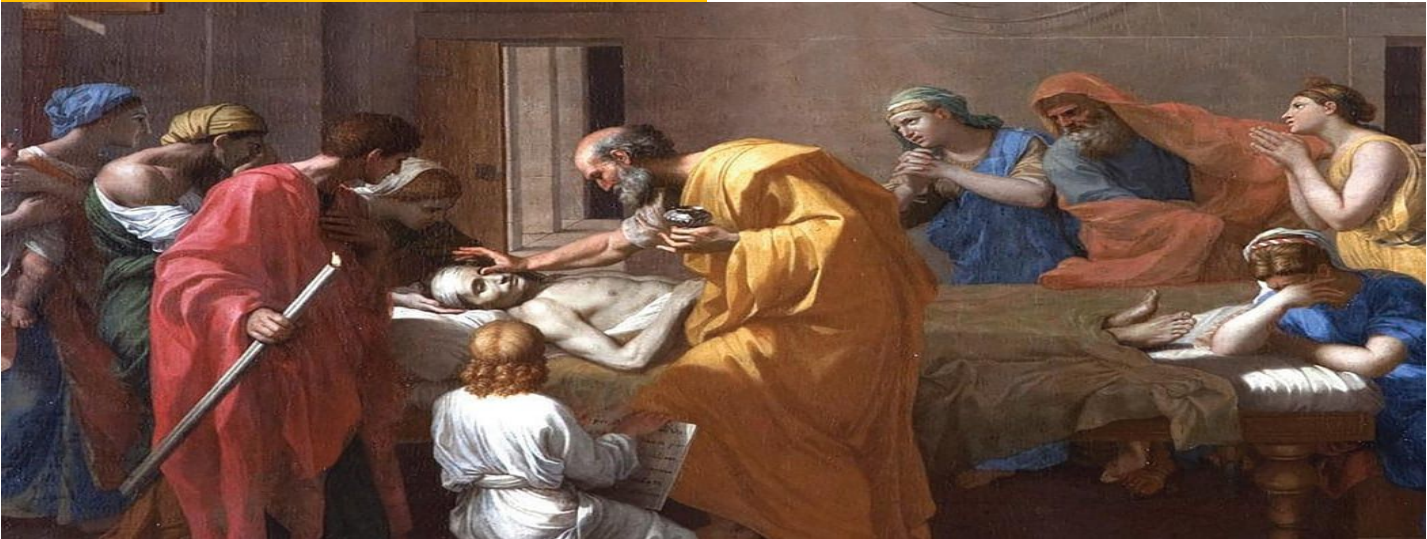

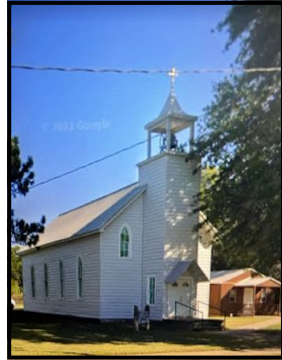

Training is scheduled for **TODAY** , after Mass, for those interested.

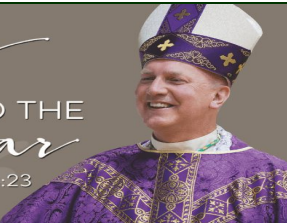
