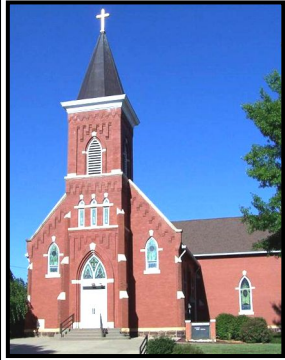
Prepare Your Heart with Fr. Agustino Torres, CFR

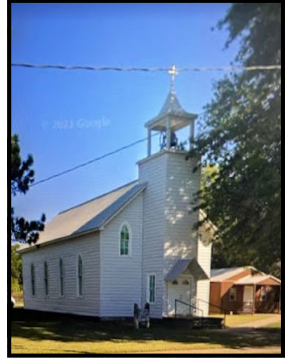

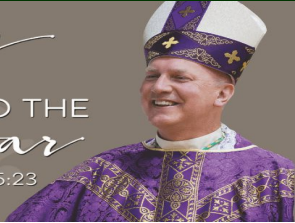

Feast of the Immaculate Conception

Feast of Immaculate Conception Mass - 6:30PM at St. Bernard

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated this year on Monday, December 9. It is a holy day of obligation. The Masses on Saturday and Sunday, even Sunday evening Masses, will be for the 2nd Sunday of Advent. There will be no Vigil Mass for the holy day on Sunday evening. To fulfill both obligations to participate in Mass, one must attend one Mass for the Sunday and one for the holy day. In parishes where there is a Sunday evening Mass, attending that Mass can count for the holy day obligation, even though the readings and prayers are for the 2nd Sunday of Advent. However, it may not count for both the Sunday and the Holy Day obligation. Lastly, a reminder that funeral Masses may not be celebrated on this or any other holy day of obligation. - Father Frank Coady
