

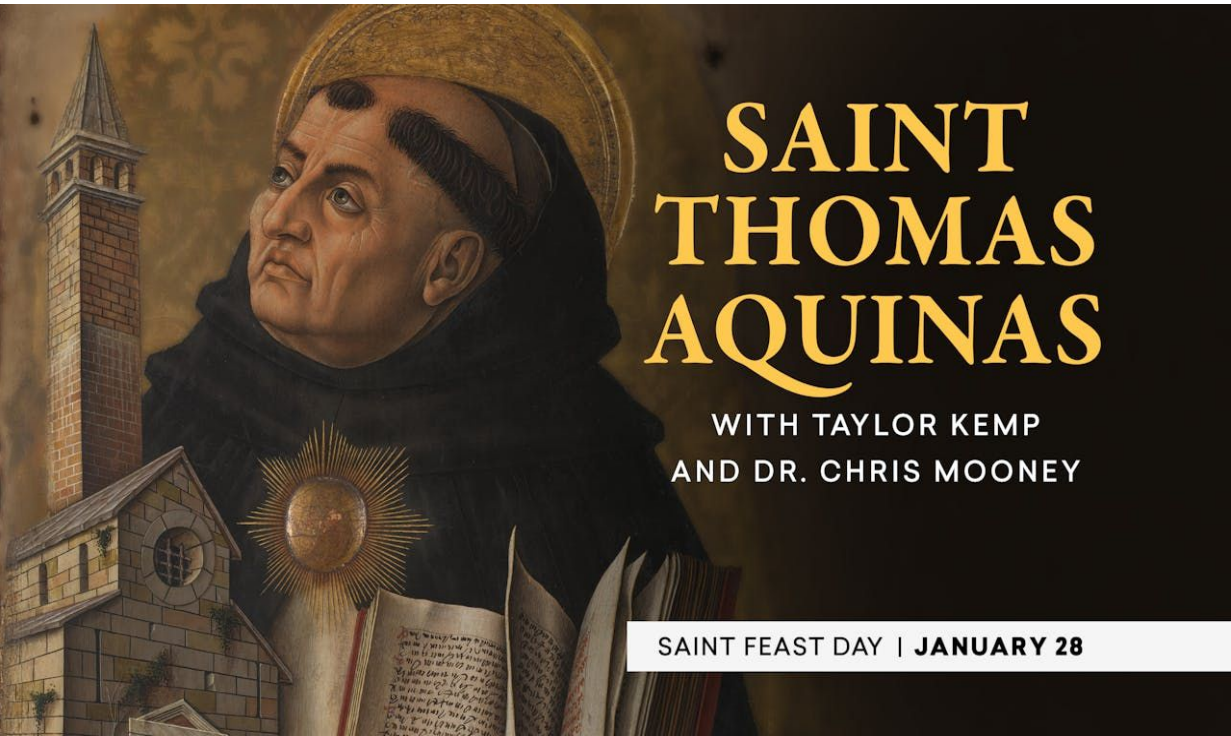

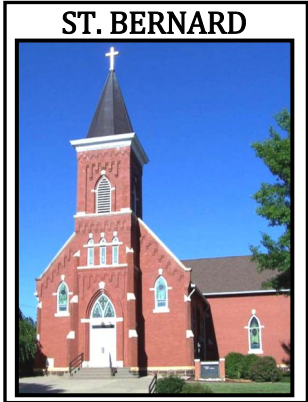

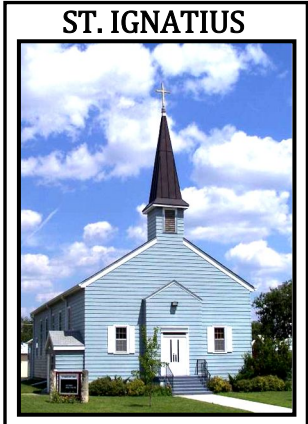

The Sacraments

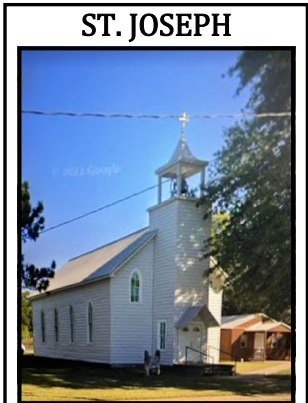
Baptism - By appointment after completion of required instructions.
