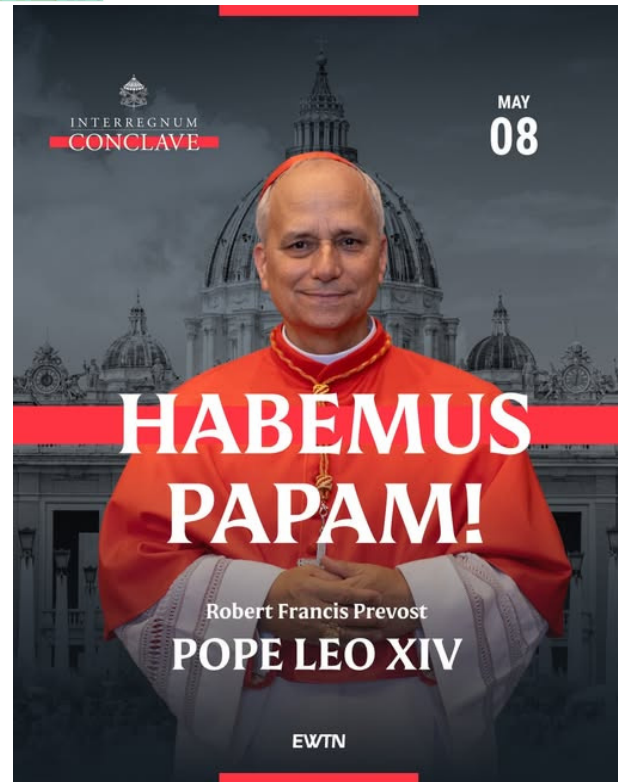
Mother's Day BREAKFAST FUNDRAISER

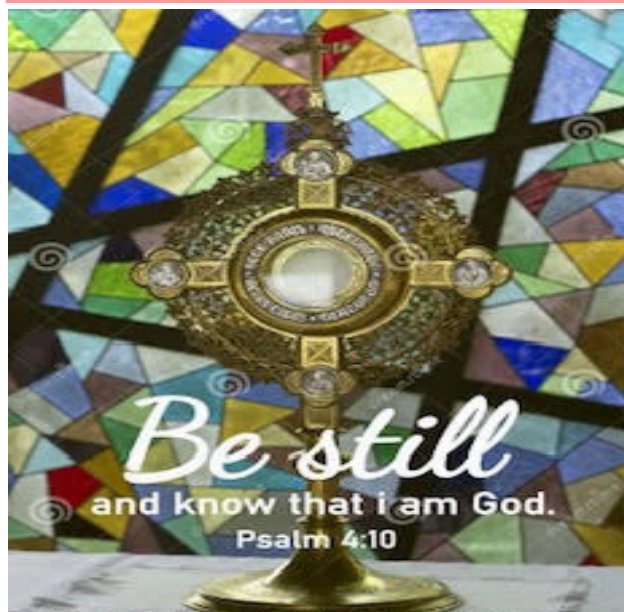

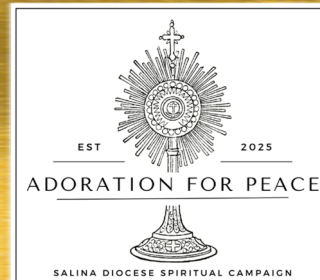
