

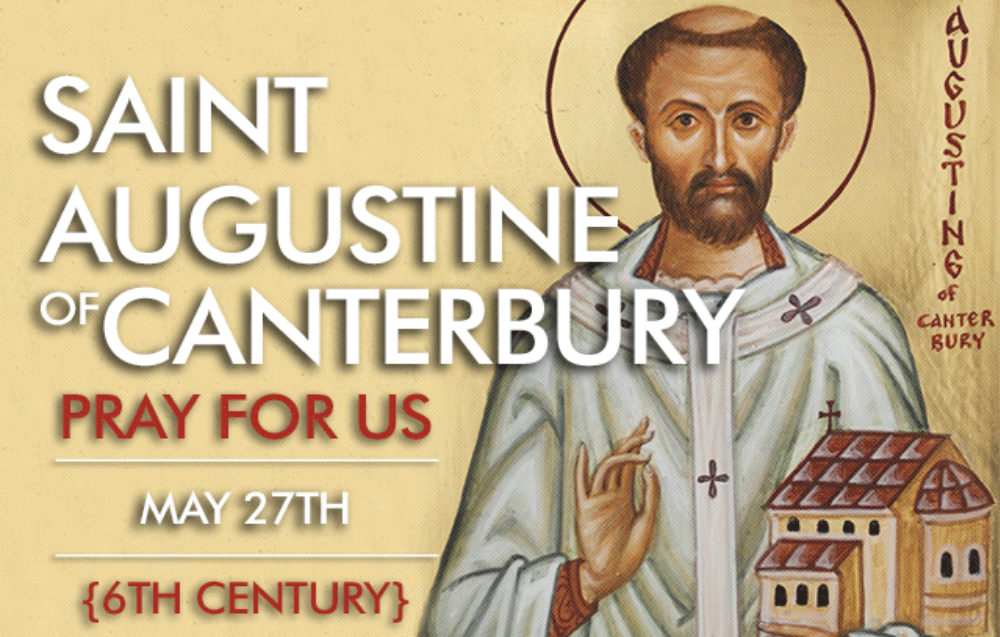

ST. AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY, KNOWN AS THE “APOSTLE OF THE ENGLISH,” WAS A BENEDICTINE MONK AND THE FIRST ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY. POPE GREGORY THE GREAT ASKED AUGUSTINE TO LEAD A MISSION TO EVANGELIZE THE ANGLO-SAXONS IN ENGLAND. EVEN UNDER TRYING CONDITIONS, AUGUSTINE LED AND ENCOURAGED THE GROUP AND ULTIMATELY HIS TRIP WAS VERY SUCCESSFUL, CONVERTING KING ÆTHELBERT OF KENT AND ONE THOUSAND ANGLO-SAXONS DURING CHRISTMAS MASS IN 597. AUGUSTINE ALSO ORGANIZED CATHOLICISM IN ENGLAND AS A WHOLE, CONSECRATING THE 1ST BISHOP OF LONDON AND ROCHESTER AND SETTING THE FOUNDATION FOR THE FUTURE OF CHRISTIANITY ON THE ISLAND.
