Sick calls/Anointing - Please call the parish office if someone is hospitalized or ill at home and needs the Sacrament of the Sick.

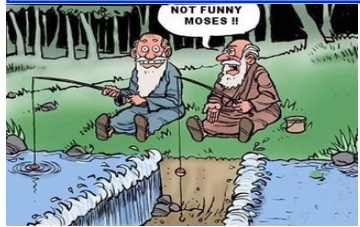

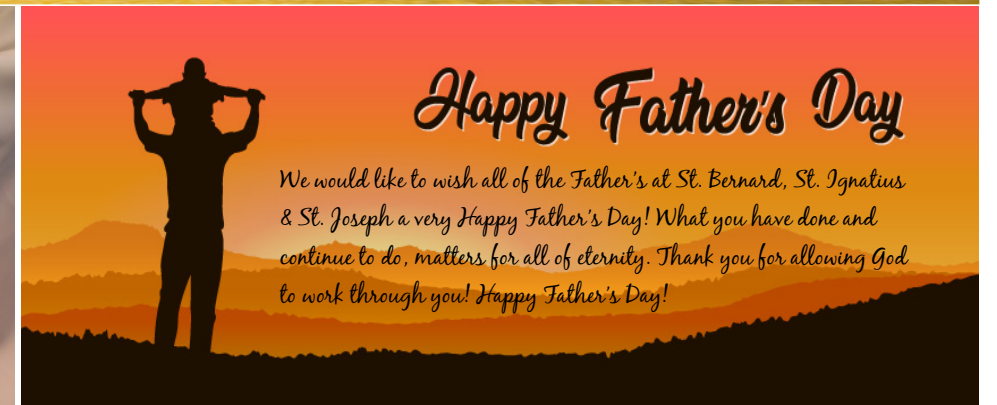
QUESTION: WHAT IS A EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION?

ANSWER: A EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION IS A PUBLIC DISPLAY OF FAITH AND REVERENCE FOR THE EUCHARIST, SPECIFICALLY THE BELIEF IN JESUS' REAL PRESENCE IN THE CONSECRATED BREAD AND WINE. IT'S LIKE A "HOLY PARADE" WHERE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT, PLACED IN A MONSTRANCE, IS CARRIED THROUGH THE STREETS OR OTHER DESIGNATED AREAS, ACCOMPANIED BY THE FAITHFUL. THE PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSION IS TO PUBLICLY HONOR GOD, WITNESS TO THE FAITH, AND INVITE THE COMMUNITY TO ENCOUNTER CHRIST.
