SAINT JUNÍPERO SERRA WAS BORN AT PETRA, MAJORCA, SPAIN, NOVEMBER 24, 1713, A SON OF ANTONIO NADAL SERRA AND MARGARITA ROSA FERRER WHO SPENT THEIR LIVES AS FARMERS. JUNÍPERO SERRA WAS BAPTIZED ON THE SAME DAY AT ST. PETER’S CHURCH AND WAS GIVEN THE NAME MIGUEL JOSÉ. IN PETRA, SERRA ATTENDED THE PRIMARY SCHOOL OF THE FRANCISCANS. AT 15-YEARS-OLD, HE WAS TAKEN BY HIS PARENTS TO PALMA TO BE PLACED IN THE CHARGE OF A CATHEDRAL CANON, AND HE BEGAN TO ASSIST AT CLASSES IN PHILOSOPHY HELD IN THE FRANCISCAN MONASTERY OF SAN FRANCISCO.

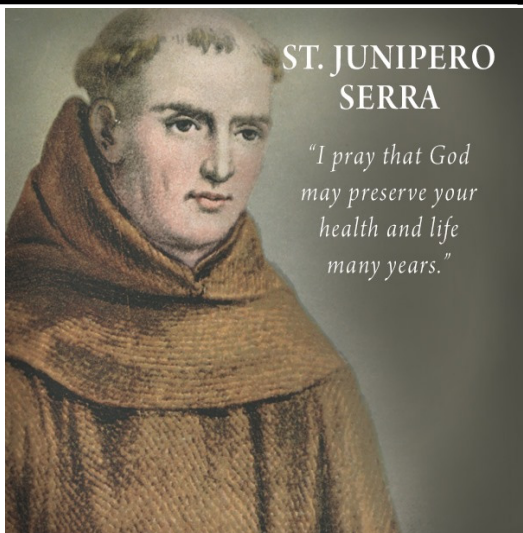
SAINT JUNÍPERO SERRA FOUND HIS DEEPEST HAPPINESS ON EARTH BY DEVOTING HIS UNIQUE TEACHING TALENTS TO CARE FOR THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES OF MODERN-DAY CALIFORNIA.

SERRA WAS A FRANCISCAN FRIAR WORKING AS A RENOWNED PROFESSOR IN SPAIN. HE USED HIS TALENTS TO THE UTMOST THERE BUT DIDN’T FEEL HE WAS BRINGING THEM TO THE PEOPLE WHO NEEDED THEM MOST. SO, IN 1749, SERRA TOOK A SHIP TO MEXICO. HE SLOWLY MADE HIS WAY UP INTO CALIFORNIA, TEACHING NATIVE AMERICANS ALONG THE WAY.

IN HIS WORK WITH THE NATIVE AMERICANS, SERRA LEARNED THEIR LANGUAGE, AND WHOLE NATIVE PEOPLES CONVERTED TO CATHOLICISM BECAUSE OF HIS PASSIONATE TEACHING. WHEN THEIR RIGHTS OR LAND WERE THREATENED, SERRA DEFENDED THEM WITHOUT BUDGING.

IN 1769, SERRA ESTABLISHED THE FIRST OF NINE MISSION CENTERS IN CALIFORNIA, STARTING WITH MISSION SAN DIEGO DE ALCALÁ. THESE MISSIONS LAID THE FOUNDATIONS FOR THE SPREAD OF CHRISTIANITY ON THE PACIFIC COAST OF WHAT IS NOW THE UNITED STATES. SERRA’S APPROACH TO MISSION WORK WAS MULTIFACETED, INVOLVING THE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE, EDUCATION, AND INFRASTRUCTURE ALONGSIDE SPIRITUAL INSTRUCTION. HE REMAINED FULLY DEDICATED TO HIS MISSION WORK WITH NATIVE AMERICANS UNTIL HIS DEATH ON AUGUST 28, 1784.

ON SEPTEMBER 25, 1988 SERRA WAS BEATIFIED BY POPE JOHN PAUL II. WHILE VISITING AMERICA, POPE FRANCIS CANONIZED JUNIPERO SERRA ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2015. DURING A MASS IN WASHINGTON, DC.

Mission Cooperative

The Catholic Diocese of Geita is one of the 34 Catholic Dioceses in Tanzania. Catholicism is growing fast in Geita. While this is a blessing from the Almighty God, there are also some challenges facing us in our endeavor to evangelize. Our Mission Appeal this year is to help Geita tackle some of those challenges. The proceeds from Mission appeal will help tackle these three challenges.

1. FAITH FORMATION AND EVANGELIZATION: the money will be used to provide education to 43 seminarians, 80 catechists, and over 300 girls in our Catholic schools.

2. SHORTAGE OF WATER: The Diocese of Geita has started a water project which intends to bring water to 94 villages. So far so good, we have already drilled 18 water wells and two are currently in progress.

3. Lastly, the CONSTRUCTION OF A HOSPITAL. We have already started the project but it is going very slowly because of lack of funds.
